We are looking for anything that is NOT glass and that could theoretically fit on a counter top. Please wash them prior to bringing them to school.



- Some suggestions:
- gallon and half gallon jugs
 - juice cartons
 - waxed containers (like the jumbo box of Goldfish crackers)
 - soda bottles (one liter or larger)
 - plastic shoe box-sized storage bins
 - ice cream containers (boxes and buckets)
 - unwanted pitchers
 - protein powder containers
 - laundry detergent containers
 - plastic buckets



We hope to have several hundred containers so keep sending them in!
