



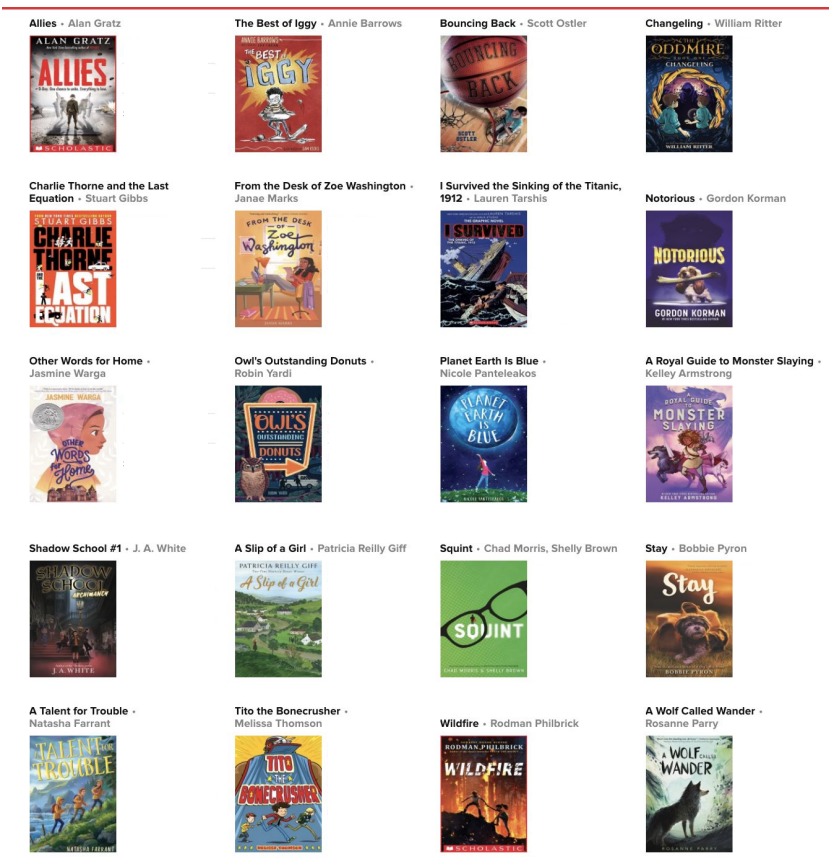
Cawley Middle School Grade Six Suggested Summer Reading List
